#### Notifications

Open Notifications	Swipe down from the top of the screen.	Open Quick Settings	Swipe down twice from the top of the screen, or use two fingers to swipe down once.
Clear All Notifications	Swipe down to view notifications and tap 'Clear' or 'Clear all' (if available).	Edit Quick Settings	Tap the pencil icon in the Quick Settings panel to customize tiles.
Snooze Notifications	Swipe slightly left on a notification and tap the clock icon to snooze. (If available)		

## **Text Selection & Editing**

#### **Text Selection**

Select Text Tap and hold on a word, then drag the selection handles to select more text.	
Copy/Cut/Paste	After selecting text, options for copy, cut, and paste will appear.
Select All	Double tap the selected word, then select 'Select All' option. (If available)
