File Operations

Ctrl + N	New score
Ctrl + O	Open score
Ctrl + S	Save score
Ctrl + Shift + S	Save score as...
Ctrl + P	Print score
Ctrl + W	Close score

Navigation

Spacebar	Play/Stop playback
Arrow Keys	Navigate between notes
Home	Go to beginning of the score
End	Go to end of the score
Page Up/Down	Scroll page up/down
Ctrl + Left/Right Arrow	Jump to the next/previous beat

Edit Operations

Ctrl + Z	Undo
Ctrl + Y or Ctrl + Shift + Z	Redo
Ctrl + X	Cut
Ctrl + C	Copy
Ctrl + V	Paste
Delete	Delete selected note(s)/rest(s)

Note Input and Editing

Basic Note Input

Number Keys (0-9)	Enter fret number on selected string
+ (Plus)	Increase note value (e.g., from eighth to quarter)
- (Minus)	Decrease note value (e.g., from quarter to eighth)
. (Period)	Add a dot to the note (increase duration by half)
0 (on numpad)	Enter a rest
9 (on numpad)	Change to next string

Note Editing

Q	Tie note to the next note
H	Hammer-on
P	Pull-off
B	Bend
S	Slide
V	Vibrato

# (Shift + 3)	Sharp
b	Flat
Natural	Natural

Display and Preferences

View Options

Ctrl + E	Toggle Edit Mode
Ctrl + T	Toggle Track View
Ctrl + I	Score information
Ctrl + F11	Fullscreen Mode

Preferences & Settings

Access preferences through the <b>Tools</b> menu, then select <b>Options</b> to customize various settings like display, sound, and input devices.
Customize keyboard shortcuts by navigating to <b>Tools &gt; Options &gt; Shortcuts</b> .

Zooming

Ctrl + Mouse Wheel Up	Zoom In
Ctrl + Mouse Wheel Down	Zoom Out

Advanced Features

Tempo and Time Signature

Double-click on tempo text	Edit the tempo in the tempo track
Double-click on Time Signature	Edit Time Signature

Track Management

Add or remove tracks using the <b>Track</b> menu. Manage track properties (instrument, volume, pan) in the track view ( <b>Ctrl + T</b> ).

Use automation lanes (volume, pan, etc.) to create dynamic changes in your score. Access automation through the <b>View</b> menu.
